FAQ #1:

What is a “studio”?

A studio is a 1-room apartment, similar to a hotel room. A studio does not have a kitchen.

Our studio apartments have a tiled area with a cabinet and sink, a 4-foot tall refrigerator with a freezer, and a microwave. There is also a separate, private, full bathroom.

Our studios also have a carpeted area, furnished with a full-sized bed, a night stand, a desk and chair, a dresser, and a TV. Larger studios may have a sofa chair or a loveseat.

We have several **types** of studio apartments:

Basic. The carpeted area of our basic studio is 13'4" x 13'6". The tiled area is approx. 7"x8". We have basic studios that open onto the front sidewalk, the back sidewalk or the 2nd floor breezeways.

Large. We have several large studios. The carpeted area measures 15'11" x 13'6" and the tiled area is approx 9'6"x8'. The cabinet extends across the back of the tiled area and has 2 sinks (one ceramic, one stainless steel). These units are all on the ground floor. Most of them open to the back sidewalk.

Expanded. Despite its' name, the expanded studio actually has the smallest floor space, but it is the only studio with access to a kitchen with a stove/oven. The carpeted area is 13'6" x 11'4" and the tiled area is approx. 3" x 8". These units are on the 2nd and 3rd floors and open into a secured hallway. There are 3 expanded studios built off each hallway, as well as a partial kitchen with counter, sink and stove. You would still have the refrigerator and microwave in your studio.

Small. We only have 2 of these, and they are definitely the least expensive unit here. A small studio is the same size as the expanded studio, but with a door that opens onto the 1st floor sidewalk and has NO access to a hallway or kitchen.

I have floor plans available to help you visualize the studio set-up.
